Thanks for your entry to the **Kirtons 600** on **Saturday 10th June 2023** starting at **6am**. My recent Llanfair 400 might have clashed with the Coronation, but this time I've gone for the big one - the Champions League Final.

There is a change of route from last year's edition. I have reinstated controls at Gainsborough and Donington and brought back the ride alongside the River Witham.

Start: In the Methodist Church Hall, next to Waitrose off Park Lane in Poynton (**SJ 923 836 - SK12 1RD**) for teas or coffee, toast and jam, and toilets. We'll supply boiling water if you want to bring one of those instant porridge pots. We have used the adjacent car park for years without incident (but at your own risk – the free long term spaces are at the far end beyond the line of trees.

Friday night accommodation: we have the Church Hall from 18:00 Friday, so let me know if you want to reserve your floor space and I will supply airbeds and blankets (this accommodation is free but a donation of £5 on the day won't be refused). Alternatively, you can try the nearby Adlington Travelodge or Elm Beds Caravan Park.

eBrevet: Download 23-67 onto your phone and register the first control before you leave. The controls can be activated anywhere within ½km of the control locations as defined by the route sheet. Note that with the first control is only at 29km, so if you are out of time, answer the Info instead. If you don't use the app, please collect till receipts from each control location.

Finish Control: There will be a controller in the Church Hall from 6pm to 10pm. If you finish earlier than that, pop your completed Brevet Card and any till receipts in the post box outside the Church Hall. Don't forget to register the finish control and upload the eBrevet. You must ensure you are rested before driving home.

Left Luggage: If you want to leave a small bag at the HQ, please let me know *before the day* so that we can arrange its return. It won't be available until after 6pm on Sunday.

Corby Glen: We have the village hall as a control at 355km for hot food and drinks. There will be air beds and blankets but we may limit your sleep to 3 hours as space is limited. You need to reach the next control by 9am, which is 62km away, so don't stay too long.

Overnight Controls: You should carry sufficient supplies during the night as not all 24-hour businesses have resumed round the clock service after Covid. McDonalds in Boston is supposed to be open 24-hours, but may be drive-thru only after 11pm so not available to you. The nearby ASDA is supposed to be open 24-hours.
